

The Mercy College Hoffman Ambassador Program is a group of ten students committed to service to the Toledo and Mercy College communities. Ambassadors are provided a variety of opportunities to enhance civic responsibility, leadership development, and service-learning experiences.

- Hoffman Ambassadors will gain a better understanding of values, integrity, ethics, and accountability through training, common reading, and programming on and off campus.
- Ambassadors will meet bi-weekly (1 ½ hours) as a cohort with the Ambassador Coordinator.
 The first meeting will be held at the Student Leadership Retreat, on August 17,
 2018, held at Our Lady of the Pines Retreat Center in Fremont, Ohio. Save the date!
 Projected subsequent meetings will be at a time that fits with everyone's schedule.
- Ambassadors are required to complete <u>250</u> Mercy College Hoffman Ambassador hours within the year commitment. Hours include service, training (meetings), and leadership workshops.
 Participation at each Mercy College Open House is expected. Helping with as many SOAR (Student Orientation and Registration) days as possible is also an expectation.
- Hoffman Ambassadors will receive a \$3,000 scholarship (\$1,500 per semester) from the College.
- Applications are due to Sister Sally Bohnett, SND, by Monday, July 30, 2018, 5:00 PM
 in the Campus Ministry/ Service Learning Office, Room 5720. Sister Sally is the Coordinator of
 the program.

- Demonstrated responsibility and commitment; understanding and support of the Mercy College Mission and Values
- Leadership potential and experience in church and/or civic community
- Desire to serve in the community and at Mercy College / Open to participating in Campus Ministry/ Service Learning programming
- Interest in developing personal leadership skills
- Maintain good academic standing
- Enrollment in a <u>minimum of 6 credit hours</u> at Mercy College in an Associate or Bachelor degree program
