# EMPOWER TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION COMING FEBRUARY 1, 2022

Two-factor authentication will be enabled in both the Empower Me website and the Empower client on February 1, 2022 to provide an additional layer of security beyond just a username and password. All users of Empower will be impacted, including faculty, staff, students, prospective students, and alumni. You will still sign in to Empower as usual with your username and password, but then Empower will send

an email to your personal email address with a security code. You will need to enter that security code into the security validation screen in Empower to complete the sign in process. To ensure a smooth sign in experience, please take a moment to verify your personal email address in Empower in advance by using the "Update Personal Information" option in Empower Me. If you do not have a personal email address on file in Empower, it will fall back to using your Mercy College email address. Please call the Mercy College Information Technology team at 419-251-9898 for assistance with two-factor authentication issues.

# FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN PAYMENT PAUSE EXTENDED THROUGH MAY 1, 2022

On December 22, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education extended the student loan payment pause through May 1, 2022. The pause includes the following relief measures for <u>eligible loans</u>:

- A suspension of loan payments
- A 0% interest rate
- Stopped collections on defaulted loans

Federal student loan borrowers are encouraged to use the additional time to:

- Ensure their contact information is up to date
- Consider enrolling in auto-debit
- Make sure they are on the best repayment plan for their current situation

Borrowers can find the most up-to-date information <u>here</u>. The U.S. Department of Education is holding a webinar on February 23, 2022; 2-3p.m. ET. This webinar is intended for stakeholders and key partners and will provide information on how borrowers can prepare for the end of the payment pause. Additionally, stay tuned for upcoming updates to the <u>Return to Repayment Toolkit</u>.



### Allison Armstrong '15 – ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

Congratulations to Mercy alum Allison Armstrong on being named the new Chief of the Toledo Fire & Rescue Department (TFD)! Armstrong earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Mercy in 2015. She joined the TFD in July 2000, was promoted to lieutenant in 2010, captain in 2011, and battalion chief in 2019.

Battalion Chief Allison Armstrong will begin her first day as chief on February 4, 2022. "I feel honored, I feel grateful," Armstrong said. "I'm

excited to be a mentor to girls and young women. I think it helps when they see someone in these positions, and they realize they can do this and it's not just for boys... I believe public service is a privilege and a calling," she said. "I feel blessed to enjoy my job and serve the citizens of Toledo. I look forward to this amazing opportunity and starting this next chapter of my career."

The online <u>Bachelor of Science in Nursing Completion</u> (RN to BSN) program is offered to those who already have an RN license and hold either an AND or ASN in nursing. The RN to BSN program offers all core nursing courses online and is designed for the working nurse. Start at any time, with program launches in the spring (January), summer (May), and fall (August) semesters.

Students pursuing the RN to BSN program now also have the option to take one or more (maximum of six credit-hours) 500 level graduate courses at the undergraduate tuition rate. The course options are part of the Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) program. <u>Learn more about the MSN fast-track option</u>.
